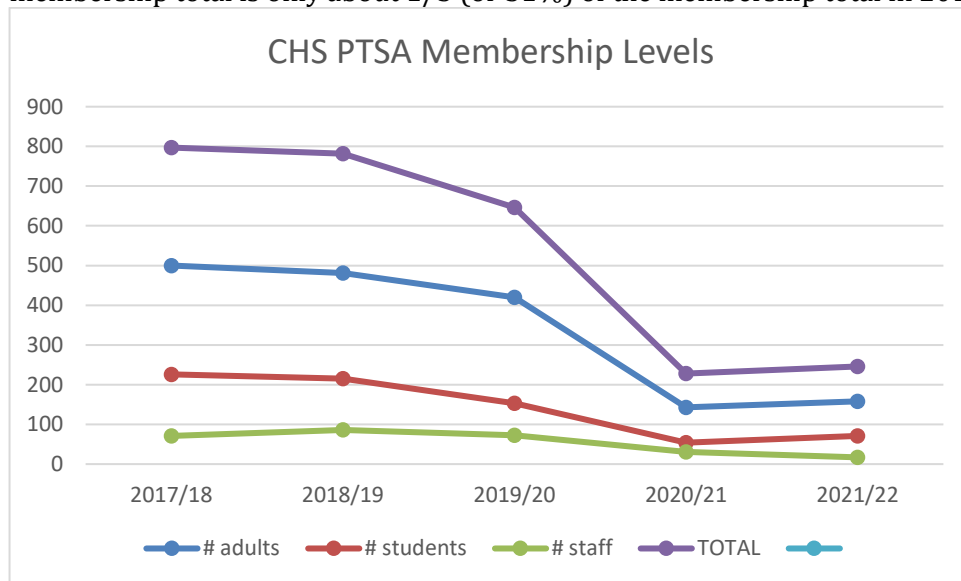

Membership

No new memberships were added during this past month. Below is a chart which shows the trend in membership levels. As can be seen, our total membership this year (246) is up a bit from last year (228), with a slight increase in membership by parents and students but a decrease in membership by staff. This chart also clearly demonstrates the drop in PTSA levels since the beginning of COVID; our current membership total is only about 1/3 (or 31%) of the membership total in 2018/19.



Treasurer

1. Confirmed with Anne Sellers and Gena Chung that up to Dec 31 2021, we had 246 all memberships, \$2390 membership donations and \$3250 membership fees. No new membership in Jan 2022.
2. Submitted the second check at \$187 for 44 membership dues to National PTA on Jan 31 2021. The first check was at \$858.5 for 202 membership dues.
